Detailed Evaluation Methods

1. Daily Performance Assessment (30%)

- Daily checklist of tasks completed
- Accuracy and precision in performing routine laboratory procedures
- Adherence to standard operating procedures
- Time management and efficiency
- Weekly progress review

2. Practical Skills Assessment (25%)

- Mid-rotation practical examination (25%)
- **Assessment will cover:**
 - Sample receiving and processing
 - Equipment operation and maintenance
 - Laboratory testing procedures
 - Results interpretation

3. Case Study Presentation (15%)

- Each student selects a clinical case encountered during rotation
- **Prepares a 15-minute presentation including:**
 - Patient history (anonymized)

- Laboratory findings
- Interpretation of results
- Correlation with clinical diagnosis
- Literature review on the condition
- Evaluated on content, critical thinking, and presentation skills

4. Laboratory Notebook (10%)

- **Daily documentation of:**
 - Procedures performed
 - New techniques learned
- **Evaluated for completeness, organization, and critical reflection**

5. Final Written Examination (15%)

- Comprehensive exam covering all departments rotated
- **Question formats:**
 - Multiple choice
 - Short answer
 - Case-based problem solving
 - Results interpretation

6. Professional Behavior Assessment (5%)

- Punctuality and attendance
- Professional appearance and adherence to dress code
- Communication with patients, staff, and peers
- Teamwork capabilities
- Ethical conduct and patient confidentiality
- Initiative and willingness to learn
